<b>Applicant</b>	Demirtas Ltd
<b>Premises:</b>	Inter Food and Wine 386-388 Bearwood Road Smethwick B66 4EX
<b>Ward:</b>	Abbey

**1. Purpose of the Report**

- 1.1 To advise members of an application made under section 34 of the Licensing Act 2003 for a variation of a premises licence in respect of Inter Food and Wine, 385-388 Bearwood Road, Smethwick B66 4EX
- 1.2 The Licensing Panel is required to consider this application and having regard to any representations, take such steps as it considers necessary for the promotion of the licensing objectives.

**2. The Premises and licence history.**

- 2.1 The premises is a shop selling alcohol. It is currently subject to a licence that was granted on 13 April 2007. Conditions were attached to the licence following a review by Trading Standards on 15 January 2009, at that time the Premises Licence Holder and Designated Premise Supervisor was Halil Er. On the 15 January 2009 the licence was transferred to Ercan Er who also became the Designated Premise Supervisor.
- 2.2. On 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2015 the licence was transferred to Demirtas Ltd the present Premises Licence Holder and the Designated Premise Supervisor was varied to Hasan Tedemir who is the current Designated Premises Supervisor.

- 2.3 A review hearing took place on 9 February 2016 when the committee attached further conditions to the licence. The review was brought by Trading Standards.
- 2.4 The current licence permits the sale of alcohol for consumption off the premises from 7am to 11pm every day.
- 2.5 A copy of the current licence is appended as Appendix 1.

### **3. The Application**

- 3.1 The application before the committee today is made by Demirtas Ltd., Inter Food and Wine, 386-388 Bearwood Road, Smethwick B66 4EX.
- 3.2 The licence applied for is for a variation of the current licence to permit the sales of alcohol for consumption off the premises for a 24 hour period every day.
- 3.3 A copy of the application is appended as Appendix 2

### **4. Relevant Representations**

- 4.1 Under the Licensing Act 2003, a responsible authority or any other person may make representations in respect of the application which must be relevant to one or more of the licensing objectives. Representations made by a person other than a responsible authority must not be frivolous, vexatious or repetitious.
- 4.2 A relevant representation has been received from Sandwell Metropolitan Borough Council Trading Standards, a responsible authority. The representation is relevant to the prevention of crime and disorder objective.
- 4.3 The representations are attached at Appendix 3.

## **5. Matters Relevant to the Application**

- 5.1 Members of the Licensing Panel must make decisions with a view to promoting the licensing objectives which are:-
- i) the prevention of crime and disorder;
  - ii) public safety;
  - iii) the prevention of public nuisance;
  - iv) The protection of children from harm.

## **6. Options Available to the Panel**

The steps are—

- (a) to modify the conditions of the licence;
- (b) to reject the whole or part of the application;

and for this purpose the conditions of the licence are modified if any of them is altered or omitted or any new condition is added.
