<b>Premises:</b>	190 Hamstead Road, Great Barr
<b>Ward:</b>	12- Newton

**1. Purpose of the Report**

- 1.1 To advise members of an application made under section 17 of the Licensing Act 2003 for a premises licence in respect of 190 Hamstead Road, Great Barr
- 1.2 The Licensing Panel is required to consider this application and having regard to any representations, take such steps as it considers necessary for the promotion of the licensing objectives.

**2. The Premises**

- 2.1 The Premises is described as 'a fast food store with a store room'.
- 2.2 The location and proximity to neighbouring premises can be seen on the location map provided which is attached at Appendix 2.

**3. The Application**

- 3.1 Application is made by Jaswinder Singh Gill.
- 3.2 The licence applied for is to permit; Sales of alcohol for consumption off the premises from 1200 to 2200 Monday to Saturday.

- 3.3 The proposed hours of opening are 1200 to 2200 Monday to Saturday.
- 3.4 The proposed Designated Premises Supervisor is Jaswinder Singh Gill.
- 3.5 The application is attached at Appendix 1.

#### **4. Relevant Representations**

- 4.1 The Licensing Act 2003 permits a responsible authority or any other person to make representations in respect of the application which must be relevant to one or more of the licensing objectives. Representations made by a person other than a responsible authority must not be frivolous, vexatious or repetitious.
- 4.2 A relevant representation has been received from members of the public. The representations are relevant to the prevention of public nuisance objective and crime and disorder objectives.
- 4.3 The representation is in the form of a letter and accompanying petition.
- 4.3 The committee is advised that there is no current Cumulative Impact Policy for the Licensing Act in Sandwell.
- 4.4 The representations are attached at Appendix 3.

#### **5. Matters Relevant to the Application**

- 5.1 Members of the Licensing Panel must make decisions with a view to promoting the licensing objectives which are:-
  - i) the prevention of crime and disorder;
  - ii) public safety;
  - iii) the prevention of public nuisance;
  - iv) the protection of children from harm.

#### **6. Options Available to the Panel**

- 6.1 The licensing authority may

- i) Grant the licence subject to conditions as are consistent with the operating schedule accompanying the application, modified to such extent as the Authority considers necessary for the promotion of the licensing objectives and any condition which must be included in the licence.
- ii) exclude from the scope of the licence any of the licensable activities to which the application relates;
- iii) refuse to specify a person in the licence as the premises supervisor
- iv) reject the application.

6.2 The authority may grant the licence subject to different conditions in respect of different parts of the premises and different licensable activities.
