

## Cabinet Member for Highways and Environment

### Portfolio Responsibilities

*Where not otherwise reserved to the Council, a committee of the Council or other body under the Local Authority Functions Regulations, or where authority has not been delegated to a Chief Officer and, in consultation with a relevant Cabinet Member, as necessary, to take responsibility within the Cabinet for all matters relating to:*

- The improvement of the visual appearance of the Borough (the 'streetscene') to create a better place to live.
  - The policy direction for countryside management, nature reserves, parks, green spaces and visitors centres.
  - Highways network management and maintenance.
  - Transport, vehicle and plant management, and the integration of transport services provided by Council services (including special education needs).
  - Environmental services including cleansing, grounds maintenance, public conveniences and the maintenance
- The waste strategy and waste collection and disposal services, including the Council's direction and input to the integrated waste management contract.
  - The application of licensing regimes for which the Council is the designated authority, excluding alcohol and gambling.
  - Emergency planning and civil resilience.
  - The commissioning and procurement of services which fall within the remit of the Cabinet Member.
