1. Purpose of the Report

- 1.1 To advise members of an application made under section 51 of the Licensing Act 2003 for review of the Premises Licence in respect of Sklep Europa, 8-10 Carters Green, West Bromwich, B70 9LW.
- 1.2 The Licensing Panel is required to consider this application and take such steps as it considers appropriate and proportionate for the promotion of the licensing objectives.

2. The Premises

- 2.1 The licence was granted on 21 August 2015.
- 2.2 The hours permitted for Licensable Activities are 08.00 – 23.00 every day. The hours for opening are also 08.00 – 23.00 every day.
- 2.3 Barham Mohammed Hussain is the Premises Licence Holder and Designated Premises Supervisor and has been since 21 August 2015.
- 2.4 A copy of the current licence is attached at Appendix 2.

2.5 The location and proximity to neighbouring premises can be seen on the location map provided which is attached at Appendix 3.

3. The Application

3.1 The application is made by Sandwell Trading Standards for a review of the premises licence. A copy of the application is attached at Appendix 1.

3.2 The stated purpose of the review is the prevention of crime and disorder.

3.3 The licence holder has been served with a copy of the application for review.

3.4 The premises licence holder has been informed of this review and invited to attend.

4. Relevant Representations

4.1 Under the Licensing Act 2003, the premises licence holder, a responsible authority or any other person may make representations in respect of the review which must be relevant to one or more of the licensing objectives. Representations made by a person other than a responsible authority must not be frivolous, vexatious or repetitious.

4.2 No representations have been received.

5. Matters Relevant to the Application

5.1 Members of the Licensing Panel must make decisions with a view to promoting the licensing objectives which are:-

1. the prevention of crime and disorder;
2. public safety;
3. the prevention of public nuisance;
4. the protection of children from harm.

6. Options Available to the Panel

- 6.1 The licensing authority may decide that the review does not require it to take any further steps appropriate to promote the licensing objectives.
- 6.2 Where the licensing authority considers that action is appropriate and proportionate for the promotion of the licensing objectives, it may take any of the following steps:
1. to modify the conditions of the licence;
 2. to exclude a licensable activity from the scope of the licence;
 3. to remove the designated premises supervisor;
 4. to suspend the licence for a period not exceeding three months;
 5. to revoke the licence;

For these purposes the conditions of a premises licence are modified if any of them is altered or omitted or any new condition is added.
